JS Standards and Decorum Refresher

Recently, we've had captains reporting a spate of incidents with respect to jumpseat use. Please be cognizant of the jumpseat protocols, policies and expectations. The jumpseat is a privilege we all enjoy. Below is a summary, but for a full text please review FOM Chapter 26. Jumpseaters will:,

- Be subject to Delta policy and FARs concerning alcohol, medication, and certificates as on-duty pilots, whether seated in the flight deck or cabin.
- Wear uniform or business casual attire, (refer to Uniform and Business Casual.)
- Wear appropriate ID prominently displayed, (for Delta employees, this is the Company ID)
- Have no beard or goatee
- Not assume there will be room on the flight deck for their baggage
- Be unassuming, inconspicuous, and observant of sterile flight deck

In addition to the guidance above, cabin jumpseaters will:

- Introduce themselves to the captain and flight leader/purser.
- Provide the captain/flight leader/purser with a copy of their jumpseat boarding pass
- Not sleep on the jumpseat
- Not engage in personal pastimes if in uniform (e.g., reading or listening to headphones)

Additionally, as a jumpseater please do not ask to use the Class 1 Rest facility on widebody aircraft. In order to do so, the pilot must be:

- 1 In uniform
- 2 On an active rotation if deadheading
- 3 Qualified in type
